Minutes of the Selectmen Meeting of July 11, 2013

Selectmen present: Stuart E. Barwise, Patrick A. Briggs, Allen A. Daggett, Edward W. Hutchins, and Sheila Matthews-Bull

1. Call to Order.

Chair Barwise called the meeting to order at 9:05 AM.

2. Approve the July 11, 2013, Treasurer's Warrant.

Motion by Selectman Daggett, seconded by Selectman Matthews-Bull, to approve the July 11, 2013, Treasurer's Warrant. **Vote:** 5-0.

3. Other business.

Selectman Briggs wanted to congratulate the Goose Rocks Beach community for coming together for the Goose Rocks Fire Company event last weekend.

Selectman Daggett mentioned his concerns regarding vandalism at the Cape Porpoise Pier. He pointed out that just recently someone put sand in Gary Ridlon's boat engine and his boat items were thrown overboard. Also, three fuel hoses were found to have pin holes. He said this has been an ongoing problem that needs to be addressed. He pointed out there are two cameras there, but they are not well positioned. Lee McCurdy, pier manager, is ordering two more surveillance cameras.

Discussion followed:

- There is talk at the Pier that the Pier Manager is absent a lot and not working the 40 hours he is supposed to be working.
- They could ask for more police surveillance, e.g, perhaps an officer could work undercover a few nights at the Pier.
- Infrared lights could be installed with a camera.
- Motion detector lights could be installed.
- Warning signs could be posted saying "24 hour surveillance."

• The Pier Ordinance could be amended to allow only Pier members after 10 PM.

It was agreed that Selectmen Daggett and Hutchins would discuss these concerns with the Police Chief and continue this discussion at the next meeting.

Allan Moir asked the Board to approve a street opening permit for Kinder Wilson, 68 Turbats Creek Road, so that K.K. & W. Water District could install three new water services on Turbats Creek Road next week.

Motion by Selectman Hutchins, seconded by Selectman Daggett, to approve the street opening permit for Kinder Wilson for 3 new water services on Turbats Creek Road. **Vote**: 5-0.

Mr. Moir also mentioned there is a tidal pool about 700 feet wide at the west end of Goose Rocks Beach. He said he contacted the DEP and Inland Fisheries and Wildlife.

4. Adjournment.

Motion by Selectman Daggett, seconded by Selectman Hutchins to adjourn the meeting. **Vote**: 5-0.
